- 3 Accounting for shares and debentures
 Issue and redemption of ordinary shares, preference shares and debentures
- 4 Preparation of financial statements for publication purposes. Presentation of Financial statements Accounting for inventories, property, plant and equipment, leases, events after the reporting period, provisions, contingent liabilities and contingent assets
- 5 Accounting for group of companies The concept and principles of a group; preparation of consolidated financial statements, provision for unrealized profit for stock and other tangible assets, elimination of intercompany indebtedness, revaluation of PPE of subsidiary, adjustment for intercompany income and expenses including intercompany dividends, computation of goodwill/ gain from a bargain purchase, non-controlling interest & consolidated reserves
