#### **CURRICULUM REVISION**

#### OF THE FACULTY OF MANAGEMENT AND FINANCE

• The Faculty of Management and Finance at The University of Ruhuna recently completed a comprehensive curriculum revision across all its departments. After thorough faculty-level discussions, the curriculum revision has received official approval from the faculty board. Currently, the departments await comments on the revised curriculum from the external reviewers, and once their input is considered, the final approval will be sought from the University Senate and the Council.

**Department of Accountancy** has successfully revised its curriculum incorporating insights from academia, industry experts, and student feedback. The revised curriculum aims to enrich students' theoretical and practical understanding, improving their knowledge, attitude, and skills. Introducing new courses, such as ACC 31133: Corporate Finance and Risk Management, ACC 32123: Corporate Governance and Accountability, ACC 32133: Contemporary Accounting Practices, ACC 41133: Corporate Sustainability Reporting, ACC 41153: Data Analysis for Accounting Research, aims to enhance the educational experience for students and ensure they are well-prepared to navigate evolving recent developments in the field. Furthermore, existing courses underwent thorough assessments and revisions to align with the latest advancements in the field, ensuring a comprehensive and up-to-date educational experience for students.

**Department of Business Management** has successfully revised its curriculum to foster well-rounded undergraduates equipped for the demands of the contemporary world. The revised curriculum introduces 3 new courses to enhance students' skill sets. The list of new courses include MGT 22213: Socio Emotional Skills, MGT 41243: Service Management and MGT 41253: Business Performance Management. Besides, modified 9 courses encompasses, MGT 22223: Industrial and Organizational Psychology, MGT 22233: Taxation and Auditing, MGT 31223: International Business Management, MGT 31233: Business Relationship Management, MGT 31243: E-Business Management, MGT 32213: Business Research Methods, MGT 32243: Procurement and Supply Chain Management, MGT 41213: Corporate Governance and Leadership and MGT 41233: Culture and Ethics. These courses have been carefully crafted to provide students with a sophisticated education that amalgamates both traditional and contemporary aspects of business management.

Department of Management and Entrepreneurship has successfully revised its curriculum in alignment with faculty policy and based on recommendations from IQAC. Most importantly, the department has taken the initiative to alter the name of the degree in line with the curriculum revision. The new degree will be offered as BBA Hons in Business Technology and Entrepreneurship when the department implements the revised curricula. In response to emerging trends and industry demands, the department has introduced new subjects relevant to business technology, including BTE 22333: Digital Business and Electronic Commerce, BTE 31313: Innovation and Technopreneurship, BTE 31323: Digital Finance, BTE 31333: Digital Marketing, BTE 31343: Web Design and Development, BTE 32343: Computer Application in Accounting, BTE 41333: Data Analysis for Research, and BTE 41363: Business Analytics. Additionally, the department introduced a practical course module called BTE 41353: Entrepreneurship Lab, providing students with a platform to engage in real business experiences while completing their degree.

**Department of Finance** has successfully revised its curriculum in alignment with emerging trends in the evolving financial market. The revised curriculum aims to incorporate new perspectives, skills, and theoretical knowledge required to prepare students for success in the ever-changing financial sector. While revising the curriculum, numerous critical aspects have been considered, notably emerging technology, industry trends and developments, practical application, global perspectives, ethical and professional standards, and continuous improvements. Consequently, the curriculum underwent thoughtful revisions in response to the evolving requirements of contemporary finance practices, incorporating a new module such as FIN 41443: Financial

Risk Management. Furthermore, certain modules have been modified in response to recent changes in the financial sector and technological advancements. For example, FIN 31323: Financial Information Analysis has been renamed FIN 31433: Computer Applications in Accounting and Financial Analysis, and FIN 31313: Investment Analysis and Portfolio Management-I and FIN 32323: Investment Analysis and Portfolio Management II have been integrated into a single course unit titled FIN 31423: Investment and Portfolio Management Similarly, FIN 32333: Tax Planning has been reorganized as FIN 32443: Taxation and Tax Planning The course on FIN 32433: Strategic Finance moved from being taught at the 4000 Level to the second semester of the 3000 Level. Besides the aforementioned courses, all existing courses have been exhaustively examined and revised to make sure that they are continuously aligned with current trends in the industry.

Department of Human Resource Management has succesfully revised its curriculum to adapt to the changing business landscape and enhance its commitment to continuous improvement. This revision was driven by factors such as emerging technologies, a global perspective, practical application, alignment with industry expectations, and input from alumni and industry experts. To address the demands of modern HR practices, the department has introduced new modules, such as HRM 31533: Digital HRM, HRM 32513: Human Resource Audit, HRM 41513: Personal Value Creation, HRM 41533: Sustainable Human Resource Management, and HRM 41543: Human Resource Analytics. Additionally, existing modules have been updated with fresh concepts relevant to the field of Human Resource Management. This comprehensive curriculum revision reflected the department's dedication to staying current and preparing students for the dynamic challenges of the HRM profession.

Department of Marketing has successfully revised the current curriculum to align it with the panel's curriculum goals for the year 2023. This process involved incorporating insights and perspectives from academics, field experts, and former students. As a result of this comprehensive review, MKT 41613: Social Media Marketing has been introduced as a new subject, designed to address emerging trends in the marketing field. Students enrolled in this program will have exceptional opportunities to acquire in-depth knowledge of the subject through hands-on computer lab sessions complemented by theoretical foundations. Furthermore, all existing subjects have undergone updates, incorporating new concepts and theories to ensure relevance and currency. The overarching goal of this curriculum revision is to produce graduates who are not only knowledgeable but also equipped with the latest insights and skills to thrive in the contemporary business land-scape. The Department anticipates that this initiative will contribute to the development of graduates who are well-prepared for the demands of today's dynamic professional environment.

#### **4<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION – DHRM**






